The Tenuta Torciano Winery Tasting and Seminar

Rico's has asked an owner and thirteenth generation family member from the Tenuta Torciano Winery to return after a sold out event last March.

Ida Isufa is touring again the United States in order to present Tenuta Torciano's latest vintages.

Tenuta Torciano was founded in 1720 by the Giachi family, emigrating from Florence. The winery quickly became a place to eat, drink, and rest for the thousands of pilgrims that passed through San Gimignano to reach Rome. More notably, however, is

how the winery has expanded to produce renowned wines from the five major growing regions in Tuscany: Chianti, Brunello di Montalcino, Super Tuscan, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, and San Gimignano.

The focus of the evening will be a seminar-style in which Ida introduces, explains, and discusses the unique aspects of each wine. There will be about 10 wines on hand that evening, as well as Tenuta Torciano's aged balsamic vinegar and extra virgin olive oil. As it is done

at their winery, our chefs will accompany this seminar with a four course meal served family-style.
